## KEILIR GOLF CLUB

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*Ranked 1st in Iceland.*

**Keilir Golf Course** is a links golf course placed in Hafnarfjordur town, 15 minutes from downtown Reykjavik. There is a vast difference between the front nine and the back nine. The front nine is surrounded by lava, and the back nine is placed on a small peninsula at the entrance into the Hafnarfjordur harbour, with spectacular views to Snafellsjokull glacier and the Alftanes peninsula. The course demands skill and accuracy over power and distance, particularly when dealing with the lava field in the front nine!

## VESTMANNAEYJAR GOLF CLUB



*Ranked 6th in Iceland.*

**Vestmannaeyjar Golf Club** offers an extraordinary experience on Iceland's volcanic archipelago. Carved between dramatic lava formations and sweeping coastal vistas, it is one of the world's southernmost island courses. The layout demands precision, with shifting sea winds and natural contours shaping every shot. Its remote setting, framed by cliffs and the North Atlantic, delivers a round defined by raw beauty and pure, elemental golf.

## KIDJABERG GOLF CLUB



*Ranked 7th in Iceland.*

**Kidjaberg Golf Club** lies within a striking Icelandic valley where the Hvítá River winds beneath snow-dusted peaks. The course blends seamlessly with its surroundings, with fairways framed by moss-covered lava and distant glaciers on the horizon. Each hole feels carved from nature itself, offering a sense of stillness and grandeur unique to the Icelandic landscape—a captivating place to experience golf at its most elemental.

## BRAUTARHOLT GOLF CLUB

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*Ranked 2nd in Iceland.*

The golf season at the iconic **Brautarholt** is very short – lasting only five months from 1 May to 30th September – but Iceland’s northerly location allows the game to be played 24 hours a day during June and early July. This relatively new club was formed in 2011 and the layout is situated half an hour’s drive north of the capital, where the holes occupy a dramatic cliff-top and waterfront location. Designed by Edwin Roald and shaped by Michael Kelly, the course fits the landscape beautifully, with fairways and greens sites following the natural contours of the coastline.

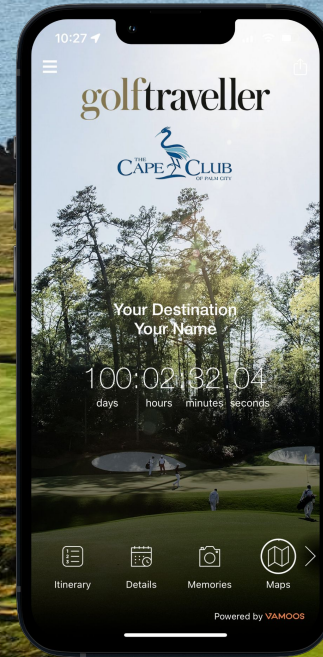
